PUMPKIN PARFAIT

INGREDIENTS

1/2 cup (120g) pumpkin puree 1 TBS maple syrup 1/2 to 1 tsp ground cinnamon (adjust according to your taste) 2/3 cup (150g) low-fat Greek yogurt 1/3 cup granola sliced strawberries (optional)

Rinsing meat can make you ill - You may think washing your turkey (or any meat) increases safety, but the CDC has recommended against turkey washing since 2005. Rinsingmeat spreads bacteria, like salmonella, to kitchen surfaces, nearby food or your clothing.

Keep it clean – Germs are especially dangerous for uncooked sides, like salad or cranberry sauce. Regularly disinfect kitchen surfaces, hands and any cooking tools you use.

Thanksgiving leftovers are the best – What would Thanksgiving be without leftovers? Reduce the time the food spends in the "danger zone" by clearing dinner off the table within two hours.

Store those leftovers properly – Cut turkey into small portions you can store in separate containers that cool more guickly in the fridge. And make sure you eat leftovers within three to four days to reduce the risk of harmful bacteria!

INSTRUCTIONS

In a small bowl, mix the pumpkin puree with the maple syrup and cinnamon. Serve the parfait in a glass, alternating between pumpkin, yogurt, and granola layers. Top with some fruit if desired.
