**THE STORY
OF THE
POINSETTIA**

Poinsettias are really colorful leaves, not flowers and are native to Central America, primarily southern Mexico. They get their American name from Joel Roberts Poinsett, the first U.S. ambassador to Mexico, who brought them to the states from Mexico in the early 1800s. They didn't become traditional holiday decorations until the entrepreneurial Ecke family started promoting them a century later. Paul Ecke Jr. sent free poinsettia plants to TV studios across the country, including "The Tonight Show" and Bob Hope's holiday specials. Eventually, the trend caught on, and now poinsettias are among the most popular plants sold in the U.S. Congress even declared December 12th to be National Poinsettia Day, the anniversary of Poinsett's death.



DID YOU KNOW?

Originally, Christmas trees were decorated with household items like apples and cookies, then paper ornaments and dolls in the early 19th century, according to History. By the 1880s, retailers like F. W. Woolworth and his five-and-dime shops (remember those?) popularized glass ornaments, often sourced from German factories where they were made by hand. To illuminate the trees, candles were the go-to option for decades, despite the fact that they would often cause fires. By the turn of the 20th century, small lanterns and glass balls that could hold the candles became more widely available. Electric Christmas lights (first invented by Edison's associate Edward Johnson) would light the way in 1900.

Exterior Holiday Decorating Guidelines

- Holiday décor can be hung the Friday after Thanksgiving and must be removed by New Years Day.
- Wreaths allowed under wall lights, but not attached to light fixture.
- No decorations are to be hung from wall lights.
- No decorations or plants allowed on stairways handrails, walkways, shrubs, lawns or carports.
- Garland is allowed on lampposts only.
- No electrical lights allowed anywhere.
- Red and Green light bulbs may replace the outside wall light only during the holiday season.
